A) Members and Member Candidates of the association believe and affirm that:

- 1. Home ownership can and should be within reach of every American family.
- 2. American homes should be well-designed, well-constructed, and well-located in attractive communities, with educational, recreational, religious, and shopping facilities accessible to all.
- 3. American home should be built under the free American enterprise system.

B) In our relationships with consumers, clients, and the general public, we believe and affirm that:

- 1. Each Member, for the protection of all parties with whom they deal, are encouraged to see that financial obligations are commitments regarding business activities are in writing, expressing the exact agreement of the parties and that copies of such agreements, at the time they are executed are placed in the hands of all parties involved.
- 2. Members agree not to obtain any business by means of fraudulent statements or by use of implications unwarranted by fact or reasonable probability.
