2025 HOME BUILDERS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE TRADES

SPONSORED BY: PROFESSIONAL WOMEN IN BUILDING COUNCIL (PWB) & HOME BUILDERS ASSOCIATION OF GREATER SIOUXLAND (HBAGS) 3900 Stadium Drive Sioux City, IA 51106

PURPOSE: To provide scholarship funds to Siouxland students wishing to continue their education at a school of higher learning in any courses related to the construction industry.

WHO QUALIFIES: To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must be a high school senior, graduating in 2025, from a Siouxland high school (if home schooled, living in the Siouxland, tri-state area), <u>and</u> be pursuing study in a building-related program, such as construction management, construction technology, civil engineering, architecture, design or any of the trade specialties at the college or university they attend (other fields may be approved if the applicant can make the connection for the committee relevant). Immediate family members of HBAGS (builder and associate members) are eligible as long as they meet all other criteria. Only those students planning on future schooling or education and training with reference to the construction industry are eligible for these awards. We are not necessarily interested in straight "A" students. A well-rounded, ambitious individual with average grades will receive every consideration.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNT: This is a one-time scholarship. The scholarship award may be up to \$2,000 per applicant. Funds are paid directly to the educational institution in the name of the student and school. Multiple applicants are chosen each year to receive scholarships.

HOW TO APPLY: Applicants must submit the following application to the PWB Scholarship Committee and:

- a letter of recommendation from the high school (i.e. counselor, teacher, principle) or an employer; and
- a copy of the student's transcript; and
- a wallet size photo of the student.

Applications will be accepted until **4:30 PM on March 21, 2025**. If an applicant is selected as a finalist, a representative of the committee will contact the applicant directly to schedule a 10-20 minute interview conducted by the PWB Scholarship Committee. Interviews will be scheduled during after-school hours in the month of April. We request the applicant please dress business casual.

PWB SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE: Shall consist of volunteers from HBAGS's PWB and a representative of the HBAGS Board of Directors. The decision of the scholarship committee shall be final.
